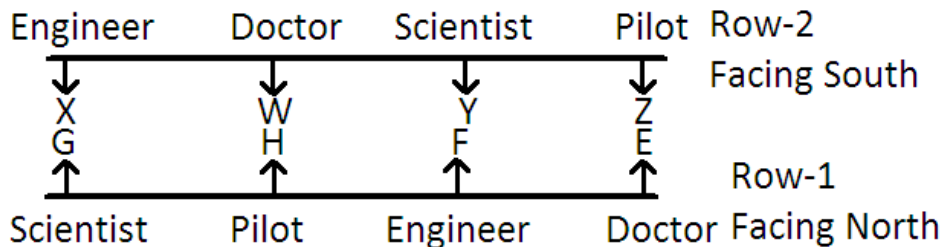

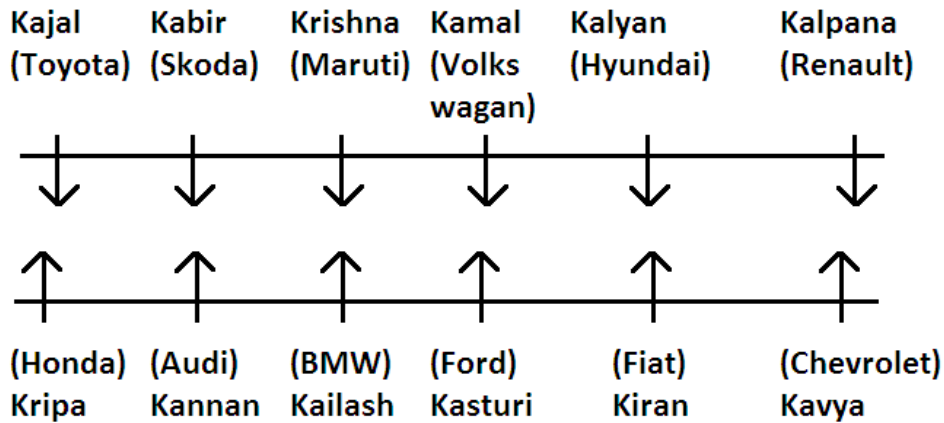
From the statement, we clearly say that inspections are carried out in the train to check the tickets.
